relation between Literature,
Philosophy, Psychoanalysis, and
Religion.**

**My suggestion is to read this work as
an answer to the question, how can
we find a basis of common life
without naive hopes or false promises
of salvation.**

Research does not result
from a **withdrawal** from
the day-to-day-world, and the
day-to-day-world should not
be understood in opposition
to research, **rather**
research and day-to-
day orientations
stimulate one another.

***Philosophy is necessary
to install a dialogue
between the disciplines
that has new parameters
for values and life
orientations.***
